Jaws PDF Editor enables users to view, assemble, mark-up, form-fill and print PDF files. Businesses can increase productivity and improve internal and external collaboration and communication using Jaws PDF Editor. Review cycles can be accelerated by using powerful electronic commenting tools such as sticky notes, a highlight pen, underlining and strikeout. Users can also easily format

and assemble business documents by inserting, extracting, rotating, and deleting PDF pages. Document navigation can be enhanced through bookmark creation and formatting tools.

Using Jaws PDF Editor as the default PDF viewer in Internet Explorer allows access to Editor's tools when viewing PDF files from the web.

View, navigate and print PDF files

Open, navigate and print PDF files using Jaws PDF Editor. View and create 40-bit and 128-bit encrypted files. Navigate via bookmarks, the page list, thumbnails, or links in addition to the standard buttons and menu commands. Search for words or phrases in the file.

Review and mark-up with comments

Create, edit, save and import and export comments directly in a PDF file. Mark-up tools include Note, Highlight, Strikeout, and Underline each with an associated pop-up comment window to add additional information. The Comments tab displays a list of all comments in the document and provides

tools to sort by type, caption, date and page.

Additionally, share comments among other reviewers using import and export comments.

Assemble PDF files

Document assembly tools include Insert, Delete, Reorder, Rotate, and Extract pages. File Open settings determine how the document displays when opened. Add, delete, format and rearrange bookmarks to enhance navigation. The Finish Document Wizard steps through a checklist of settings to prepare the file for distribution. Once changes are made, the file can then be saved.

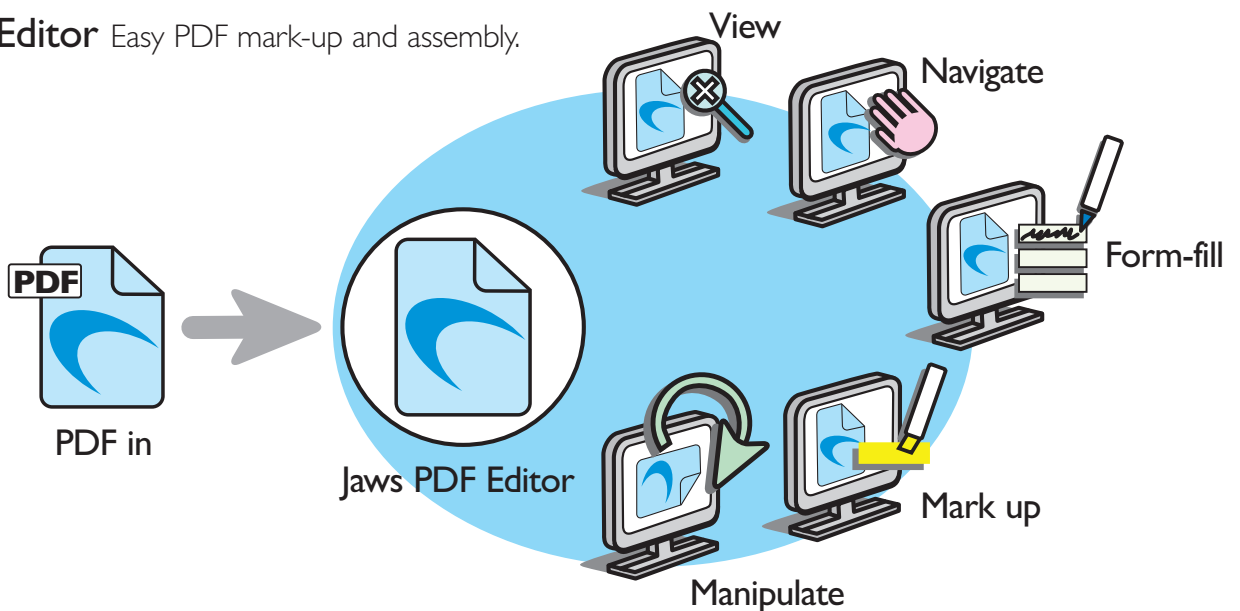
Work with PDF forms

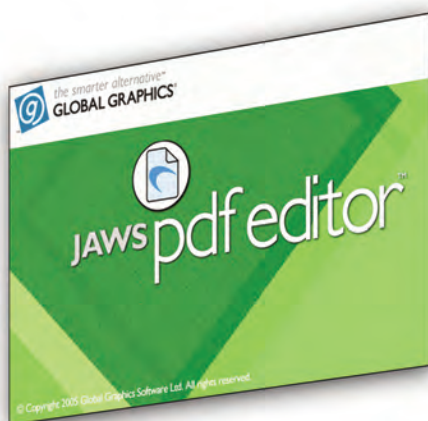
